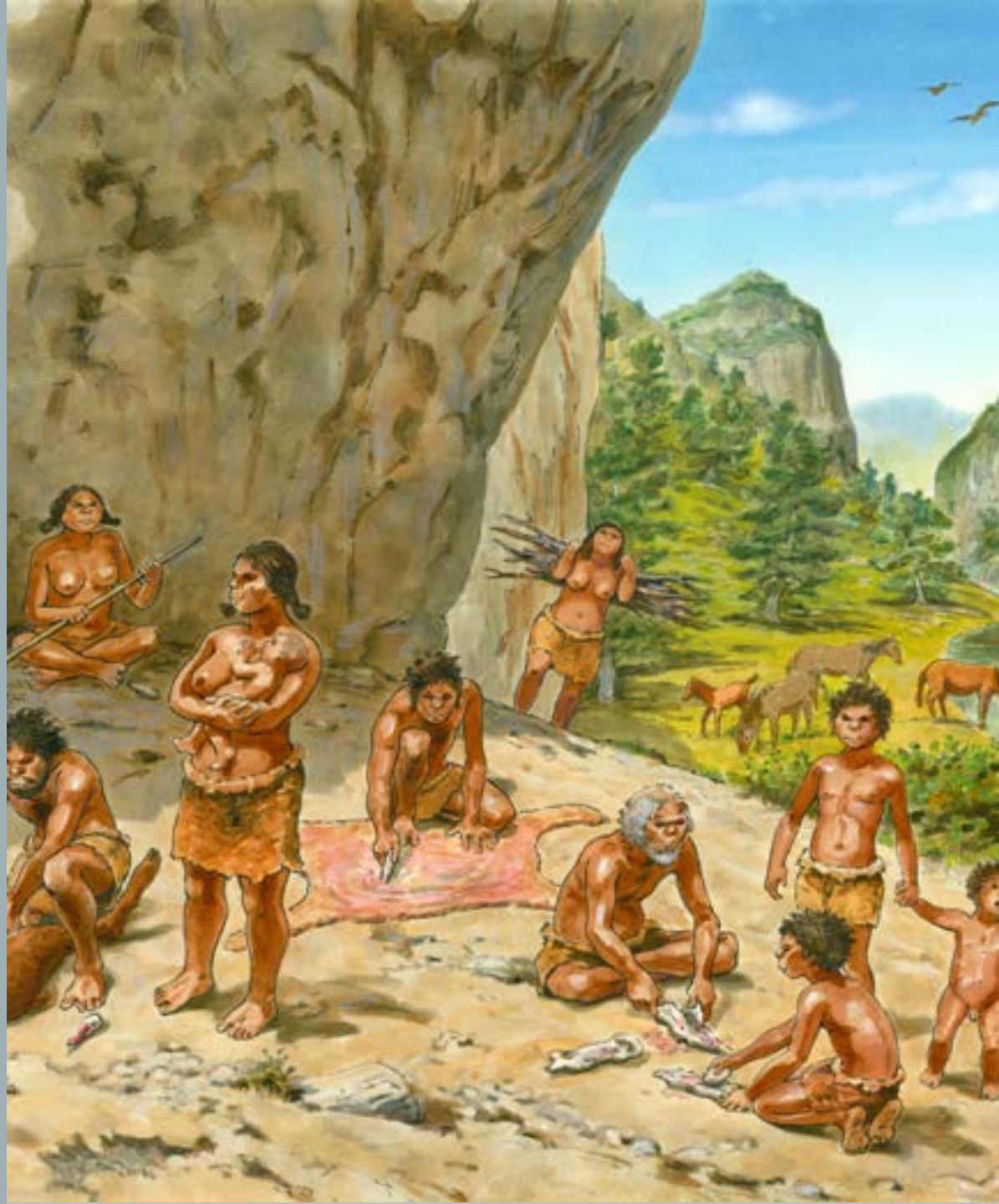
LOOKING AT IMAGES
